Counsel for the Defendant has filed a Motion to Continue Final Management Conference and Trial. The motion indicates that the State has no opposition but does not indicate how long a delay is being requested. The motion does state that the case is not ready to go to trial but does not indicate why or when it will be. The Court is concerned about possible Rule 8 implications if it continues a trial date longer than what the defense really wanted and an argument is later made that not all time should be excluded. The Court likes generic boilerplate pleadings as much as any other judge, but it should not have to guess at what is actually being requested in pleadings.

The Court also notes that the present Trial date is March 8, not March 3, 2011.
