This is the time set for Motion to Allow Television Cameras and Photographic Cameras in the Courtroom; Doug McMurdo is not present.

The Court notes that it has set this hearing to address the Arraignment tomorrow. The Court proposes to postpone these proceedings to allow the appropriate parties and legal representation to be present and to present evidence to why the Court should allow Cameras in the Courtroom for further proceedings.
